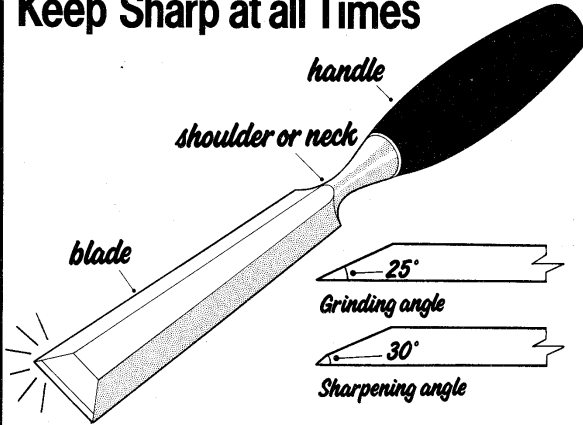

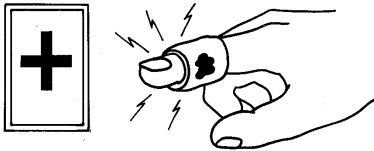

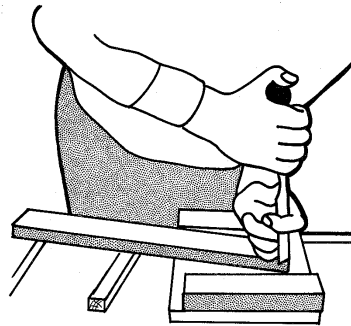
Keep Sharp at all Times



BLUNT TOOLS CAUSE:

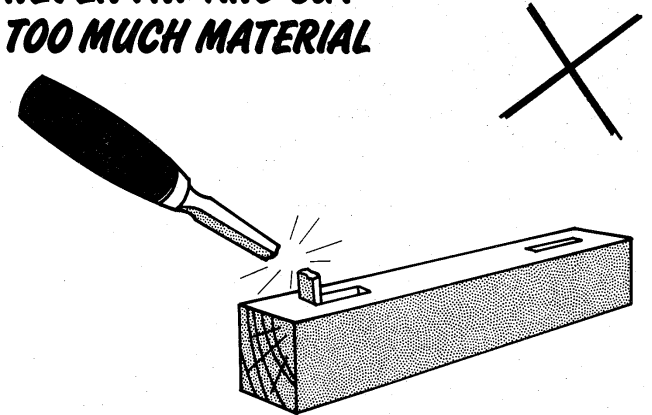


Vertical Paring:

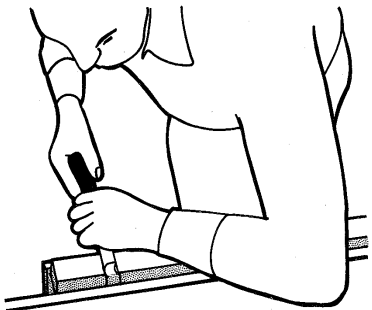


Timber supported, note position of hands.

NEVER TRY AND CUT TOO MUCH MATERIAL

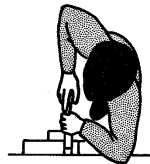


Horizontal Paring:



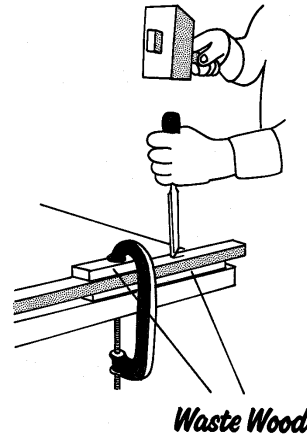
N.B. Keep all parts of the body behind cutting edge.

Note position of elbow and position of hands!

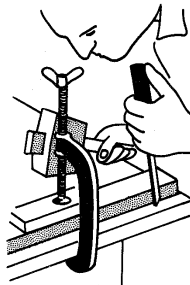


Chopping Operations

Wood secured on solid part of bench



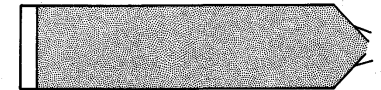
Waste Wood



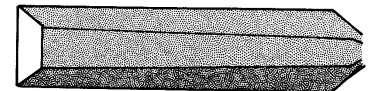
Clamp used incorrectly!

FIRMER



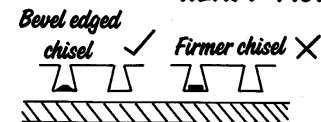
BEVEL
