





True cutting edge tool.





How to use.



For fast cutting, use at 30° angle to direction of cut.



For sculpture work, use file (with half round blade) and round file.



For smoothing and finishing, use parallel to direction of cut.



To change blades, unscrew old one. replace and screw it up.
