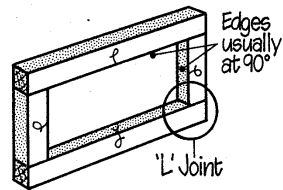

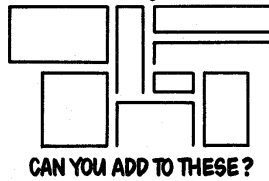

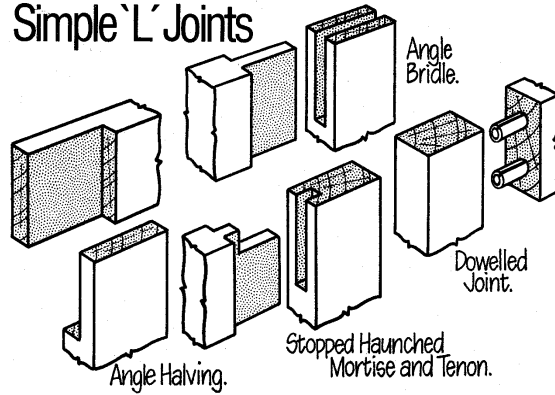
What is a Frame?



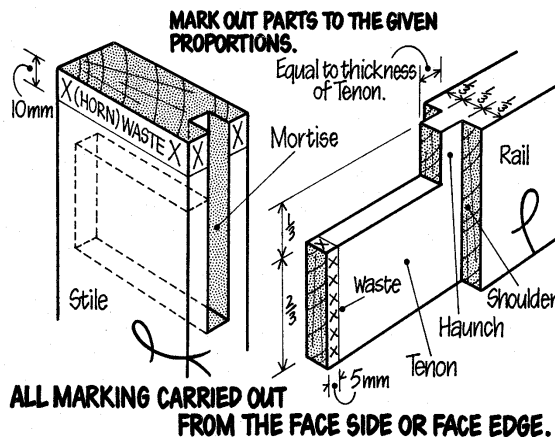
Possible shapes and arrangements.



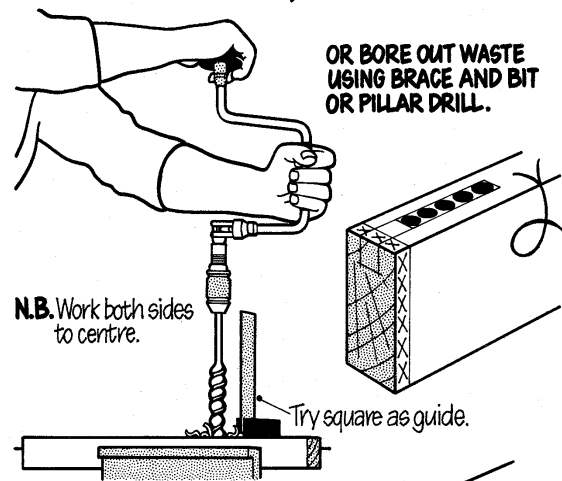
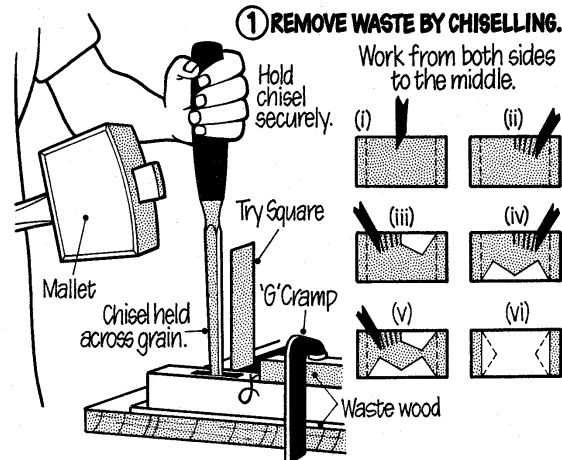
Simple L Joints



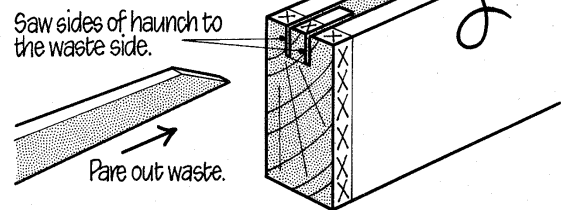
Procedure for making a Through Haunched Mortise and Tenon



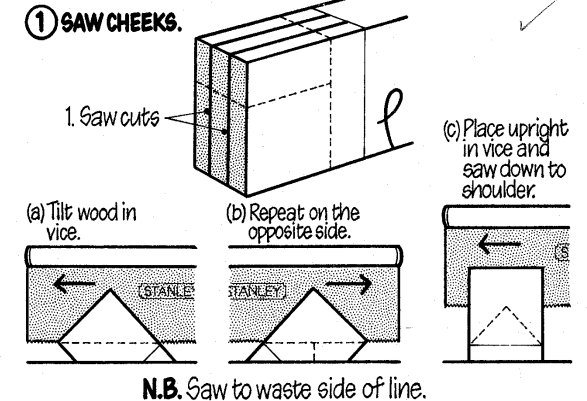
Cutting the Mortise



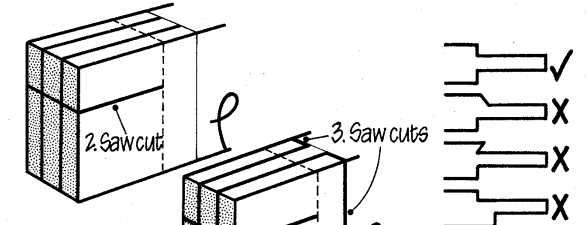
2 CLEAN OUT HAUNCH.



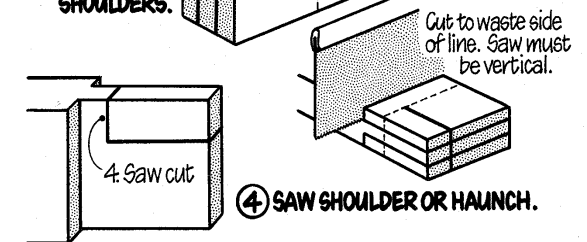
Cutting the Tenon - sawing procedure

Tools required

- MARKING OUT:** Pencil, Knife, Rule, Try Square, Marking Gauge, Mortise Gauge.
- CUTTING TOOLS:** Chisel/Mallet or Brace and Bit, Saw, Chisels.
- HOLDING AIDS:** G Cramp, Vice, Bench Hook, Holdfast.
- EXTRAS:** Waste wood to protect bench.
